Police Department:

The VIPS (volunteers in Police Service)/ CERT (Community Emergency Response Teams) Program is up and running. The VIPS/CERT group meets at 7:00 pm the first Monday of each month at Harrah Church, Reno & Dobbs. The next meeting will be August 4th.

The purpose of this program is to have an organized group of volunteers that can assist law enforcement and emergency services in the event of a disaster or major event in our city. Recent examples are the wildfire and tornado that destroyed so many homes and personal property. Some of the roles volunteers can play could range from assisting with search and rescue, transporting needed supplies and equipment to emergency personnel, answering phones, emergency first aid and cleanup. Experience is not necessary, just a genuine willingness to help other citizens in a time of need. The goal is to assist emergency personnel so that they can be where they are most needed to perform their duties when a disaster occurs.

Fire Department: Summer is here and so is the heat, humidity and dehydration. Make sure you can stay fully hydrated throughout the day by drinking plenty of fluids, as well as eating foods that are hydrating. In addition, the rising temperature brings an increased risk of wildfires. Keep trees/cedars trimmed back and away from your home. This will help decrease the chance of a wildfire destroying your home if one is in close proximity.

Parks & Recreation: Applications for craft vendors, food vendors and BBQ competitors for Market in the Park and Pigs in the Park are still being accepted. The event takes place Saturday, October 4th. The deadline for applications is Tuesday, September 30, 2014

IMPORTANT!!

Utility Department: If you are paying on our website - please be sure to use the name on the account - the address where service is provided (not your mailing address) and your account number as shown on your bill. This will ensure the proper posting of all payments.

In addition, per city policy, on the day of cut off, full payment of past due bill plus the \$30 penalty must be paid in full. The penalty cannot be carried forward to the following month.

Trash reminder: please remember that trash service includes the removal of "household trash" - trash generated inside the home. If you would like grass clippings, leaves, etc. picked up they must be bagged (bags cannot weigh more than 30 lbs each).
