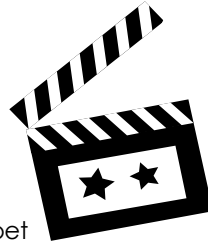

I hope you had an enjoyable Memorial Day. As the City prepares for the summer onslaught of grass and public nuisances please remember to keep your yards mowed and your property clean. As you are aware the Splash Pad has opened along with our concession stand and as usual they are packed! Everything is still go for the widening of Harrah Road from 29th Street to I40. You should see some work begin in late fall or early winter this year. It is getting close to the time for Firework Stand Permits. Please check with our Code Enforcement and City Clerk because we do have requirements that must be met in order for Firework Stands to go up in our community. The Chamber of Commerce had a successful auction and are working on their campaign to "Shop Locally"! Public Works has been patching roads that were damaged during the winter months. The tin horns have been replaced at Heritage Park and the walking trails should be repaired shortly. Hopefully we will hear soon if our Grant request to the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation is successful for new, larger playground equipment for Heritage Park. Have a great month!!!!
