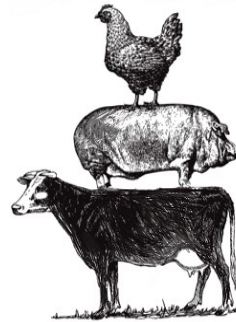

- Please, on pick up day, do not let parked cars block them.
- If you have two poly carts, please place them 3 feet apart from each other.
