METER TAMPERING IS AGAINST CITY CODE

The City Code Book states that each water customer will provide a deposit to have their utility service connected. It also states that at any time during the cutoff period the customer must come in and pay all monies due before the Utility Department will re-connect service to your residence. At no time is the customer to re-connect his/her water service on their own. City Code Book Section 10-205: TAMPERING WITH OR DAMAGING PUBLIC UTILITIES, LARCENY. TO READ FULL SECTION YOU CAN GO TO CITYOFHARRAH.COM. This action by the customer will result in a fine of \$50.00 for tampering and a possible \$559.00 fine for stealing water if ticketed by the Police Department. Please call City Hall (454-2951) if you are having issues with your meter.

HEATING SAFETY

BE FIRE SAFE IN THE HEAT OF THE MOMENT

- KEEP ANYTHING THAT CAN BURN AT LEAST 3 FEET FROM ALL HEAT SOURCES INCLUDING FIREPLACES, WOOD STOVES, RADIATORS, SPACE HEATERS, OR CANDLES
- TURN SPACE HEATERS OFF WHEN LEAVING THE ROOM OR GOING TO BED,
- PLUG PORTABLE HEATERS DIRECTLY INTO WALL OUTLETS; DON'T USE EXTENSION CORDS OR POWER STRIPS.
- USE PORTABLE HEATERS WITH AN AUTOMATIC SHUTOFF WHEN TIPPED OVER.
- NEVER USE AN OVEN TO HEAT YOUR HOME OR APARTMENT.
