City Council Meeting
March 15, 2012

The City Council for the City of Harrah met at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 15, 2012 in the City Council Room at 19625 NE 23rd Street, Harrah, Oklahoma for a Regular Meeting. Upon roll call, those found to be present were, Mayor Larry Fryar, Vice-Mayor Duane Patterson, Councilman Bill Lisby & Councilman Tom Barron. Councilman Cass Smith was unable to attend. City Attorney Robert Thompson led the salute to the flag. City Manager Earl Burson gave the invocation.
