NOTICE OF ELECTION

CITY OF HARRAH, OKLAHOMA

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of The City of Harrah, Oklahoma, in accordance with the Charter of the City of Harrah, that for the purpose of electing officers of said City a General Election, if needed, shall be held on the **3RD** day of **April**, **2018**; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following officers will be elected for a term as depicted below:

COUNCIL MEMBER: WARD 2 (Two-year term)

COUNCIL MEMBER: WARD 4 (Two-year term)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each candidate for the office of Council Member must be a qualified elector and resident of the City for a period of one year prior to filing a declaration of candidacy. The candidate with the most votes will be elected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each candidate for the office of Council Member from a ward must be a qualified elector and a resident of the City for a period of one year and a resident of the ward for a period of six months immediately prior to filing a declaration of candidacy. The candidate with the most votes will be elected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that candidates for the office of Council Member will be elected, at-large, by the qualified electors of the entire City of Harrah. The candidate from each ward with the most votes from the atlarge electorate, shall be elected to represent his or her respective ward.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any person may have his or her name placed on the ballot by filing with the secretary of the Oklahoma County Election Board during the filing period as follows:

Filing period shall open at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, the 5TH day of February, 2018 and extend through 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, the 7TH day of February, 2018

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that electors residing in this City who have the qualifications prescribed for electors by the State Constitution and Law, and by the Charter of the City of Harrah, Oklahoma and who are registered as required by law, may vote in City elections. Each qualified elector of the City shall be entitled to vote for one candidate for Council Member from each ward.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Election Board shall conduct such election pursuant to Oklahoma Statutes.
