 - a. Recommendation to amend [Ordinance No. 2017-4](#) adding new language to Chapter 12-371 under C.1. which addresses multiple-family, office, and commercial buildings **e. all non-compliant buildings shall be modified to meet the current code under the change of tenant, ownership and/or the change of use and f. all pre-engineered metal buildings shall have parapet walls extending a minimum of one foot (1') higher than the peak height of hte building on all sides excluding the rear of the building.**
 - b. Recommendation to amend Ordinance No. 2000-5 Chapter 1, [Section 102](#), modify the last section to say: **The term “weed” does not include tended crops on land zoned for agriculture use which are planted more than one hundred-fifty feet (150') from a parcel zoned for other than agricultural use, nor does it include grazing pasture for livestock that is one hundred feet (100') or more from the public right-of-way.**
 - c. Approve Lot Split for Fall Creek Addition.
