How to Prepare for Winter

If you have a vacant building turn off water supply. Leaving water lines connected can lead to leaking or bust pipes, which can cause a lot of damage.

Drain water supply to vacant buildings. Turn on the water faucets and allow the lines to drain, drain toilet tanks and flush the toilets to empty the bowls afterwards; if your water comes from a well, drain the pressure tank. If shutting off the pilot light on a water heater, drain the tank as well.

Insulate pipes: Wrap insulation around your pipes; any exposed pipes outdoors or in a crawl space should be wrapped to keep pipes from bursting in a deep freeze.

Keep the heat on if possible: Don't turn off the furnace or heater completely, just turn down the thermostat to about 50-60 degrees.

Unplug electric appliances: If you leave the electric power on but no one will be occupying a building, unplug microwave ovens, tv's and any other large appliances to avoid fire risk should there be a faulty switch or other issue.

Throw out the trash: empty all trach cans, clean out the refrigerator, if possible, unplug it and leave ajar.

As of JANUARY 2023, BIG TRASH DAY (BULKY) will no longer be picked up every month and will run quarterly:

JANUARY 9-13, 2023 APRIL 10-14, 2023 JULY 10-14, 2023 OCTOBER 9-13, 2023







Monday: Padre Pio Neighborhood, Harrah Road between Reno & 29th, Del Rey, 29th Street, and Fall Creek Neighborhood (including gated area), Legacy Point

Tuesday: All city housing that has Tuesday garbage collection pick-up on Tuesday

Wednesday: Houses that are a part of Echo Valley, Brush Creek, Hampton, and Prairie Hills area. Also, houses on Reno & 10th between Harrah road and Dobbs, Dobbs and Harrah Road between 10th and Reno.

Thursday: Any housing between Dobbs & Triple X and between 10th & North Canadian River.

Friday: Any city housing between Dobbs & Triple X and Between 10th & Reno.
