From Mayor & Council

This newsletter is intended to provide updates to the citizens of Harrah on current projects as well as planning for the future. It includes grants, Public Works (water, sewer, roads, trash service), Harrah Parks, Fire Dept, Police Dept, and Economic Development.

The Firefighter/IAFF and the Police/FOP contracts are negotiated annually. The Firefighter contract was last negotiated, approved, and accepted by the City and the IAFF on July 7, 2022, and the Police contract was last negotiated, approved, and accepted by the City and the FOP on Feb. 2, 2023. The city is currently negotiating new contracts with both the Firefighters/IAFF and the Police/FOP. The Council looks forward to reviewing the new contract proposals. It is the council's goal to have the best personnel, that are competitively paid, to protect our city.

The mayor and the council just voted to approve a 10-million-dollar loan with the Oklahoma Water Resources Board. This is needed to upgrade the undersized sewer line down Harrah Rd & upgrade the lift station so this system can support the new 2200 homes coming in the next 5-10 years. It will also provide for new sewer lines on NE 23rd from Sonic west to the Turnpike and upgrade the current lift station and pressure main to support current business as well as help attract new business to the city. The 23rd St. project will also upgrade some lines in the downtown area. The cost for Harrah Road is projected to cost 5.3 million and 23rd Street is projected to cost 4.6 million.

Many of the streets in Harrah are in extremely poor condition, so in March and April of this year the City paved part of Tim Holt Dr, Holden St, and Manek Dr. To continue improving the city streets, the mayor and council just approved the overlay of several more streets, which will include overlaying Hampton Road, Park Street, Cabin Road, and Oakridge Dr. The plan is to continuously budget funds to improve the streets throughout the city.

The Harrah Heritage Park design is almost complete, and the design should be posted on the city website within the next few weeks. It will be exciting to share the potential park design possibility with everyone.
