It has been hot! During these "dog days of summer" our city crews have worked diligently to fix several water leaks and keep up with all the mowing to keep our city looking good.

We had a great Legislative Luncheon with Estela Hernandez (Senator Lankford's field representative), 5th District Congresswoman Stephanie Bice, State Senator Shane Jett, Oklahoma County Clerk Maressa Treat, and Oklahoma County Commissioner Brian Maughan. Each participant gave us updates on the issues that are affecting Oklahomans. This was very informative. Many thanks to the Harrah Chamber of Commerce for organizing this event.

Following the Legislative Luncheon, we were able to meet with Oklahoma County Commissioner Brian Maughan about road conditions in this area and about partnering to repair, overlay, and rebuild some of the roads in the City of Harrah. Great meeting! Based on the information, the city will be working on partnerships with the county to get more roads repaired. These partnerships allow the city to combine city funding with county funding to make the money stretch further.

The city is also investigating getting high speed internet at the Harrah Heritage Park. This will allow citizens to have access and allow vendors at events to operate effectively. This is more than a convenience; this is a safety issue as we need cell phone reception in the park.

The city is moving to the next phase of improving the sewer lines on Harrah Rd and NE 23rd St. We are currently working to engineer/design the upgrades for the Harrah Rd part of this project.
