The City Council and the Harrah Planning Commission for the City of Harrah met at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, November 8, 2021 at City Hall, at 19625 NE 23rd Street, Harrah, Oklahoma for a Special Meeting.

Roll Call

At roll call the following members were present: Mayor Danny Trent, Vice-Mayor Cass Smith, Councilor Paul Wiegert, Councilor Tom Barron, and Councilor Chris Lally. Absent: None. Planning Chairman Bill Lisby, Vice-Chairman Jeff Brzozowski, Member Cary Lacefield, and Member Steve Scalzo. Others present: City Manager Mike Bower and Guest Guy Henson.

Discussion between the City Council and Harrah Planning Commission in regards to the issues the city is facing with the addition of the turnpike and the new construction throughout the city to include but not limited to: permits, applications (PUD), rezones, annexation, plats, building plans, etc. This is a workshop between the two governing bodies and no action will take place.

The purpose of this special meeting between the Harrah City Council and the Harrah Planning Commission was to bring issues surrounding the growth and development of Harrah. The two groups discussed the need to allow more time to study plans, plats, the overuse of the PUD zoning and making sure the engineer has plenty of time to review each new development and present the findings before they come back to planning and to council.
