PREPARING FOR WINTER TEMPERTURES

- Disconnect all hoses and insulate outside faucets and water pipes.
 - Winterize your home to keep the cold out.
 - Open kitchen & bathroom cabinet doors to allow warm air to circulate around the plumbing.
 - Leave a trickle of water running in pipes on outside walls or that tend to freeze.
 - Insulate your sprinkler system pipes and backflow prevention device.
 - Take care of outdoor pets and animals.
 - Clear sidewalks and driveways.
 - Have an emergency kit in case the power goes out.
