We have the opportunity for positive change in our beloved city. This April 2nd, we encourage you to participate in shaping the future of Harrah. Your vote matters, and together, we can bring about transformative improvements.

Proposed Charter Updates:

- •Term Limits Transformation:
- •Embrace progress by changing the current 2-year term for mayor and city council to 4-year terms and instituting term limits of two consecutive terms. 4-year terms will better allow the mayor and councilors to manage the complexities of governing our city. Many issues in the city have long lead times and the current 2-year terms force candidates to run for reelection before learning the complex details of governing. Although the terms will be longer, there will be limits and that ensures a steady stream of fresh perspectives and guarantees a constant flow of new ideas within our local government.
- •Residency Requirements Reimagined:
- •We understand the importance of community representation. Our proposed update mandates that council members must reside in the ward they represent, as decided by the community. In the event of relocation within city limits, council members can complete their elected term, maintaining the bond forged with their constituents.
- •City Manager Synergy:
- •To strengthen the bond between leadership and community, we recommend a residency requirement for the city manager within the corporate boundaries of Britton RD on the North, Pottawatomie County RD on the East, Triple X RD on the West and Interstate Forty (40) on the South or within Harrah School district. This ensures a deeper connection to our city and a shared commitment to its growth and prosperity.

City Beautification Efforts:

Thanks to our diligent city crews for their progress in cleaning the curbs on NE 23rd St. Let's unite and continue to beautify our great city. Every effort counts and together, we can create a more vibrant and welcoming environment for all.
