Get ready to spring into action! May is shaping up to be a fantastic month in our city parks, with a variety of events and activities for everyone to enjoy. Heritage Park, the splash pads will be open Memorial Day weekend and close Labor Day weekend. The farmers market starts every other weekend in May through September starting May 3<sup>rd</sup> from 9 am to 12 pm. At the north end of the park with new parking. As the growing season is now upon us, we want to remind everyone of the importance of maintaining their property to ensure a clean and healthy environment for our community.

**Tall Grass and Weeds:** Please be aware that grass and weeds exceeding **12 inches** in height are considered a nuisance according to city ordinances. Maintaining your lawns not only improves the appearance of our neighborhoods but also helps prevent pest infestations and other issues.

**Standing Water and Mosquito Control:** With warmer weather and potential rainfall, it's crucial to eliminate sources of stagnant water on your property. This includes old tires, uncovered swimming pools, buckets, and any other containers where water can accumulate. Stagnant water becomes a breeding ground for mosquitoes, which can be a nuisance and carry diseases.

**Bulk trash runs** each month to help keep our neighborhoods clean and manicured. The bulk schedule is posted on our website with instructions. It will be picked up on the regular scheduled weekly pick up day but at a different time than regular pick up.

**Swimming pools** must be de-chlorinated before draining. If the pool cannot be de-chlorinated it can only be drained into the city sewer.

It is unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to deposit, throw or sweep into or upon streets, alleys, parking lots or sidewalks, any paper, rubbish, grass, weeds, tree trimmings, dirt, trash, crates, boxes, or other refuse of any kind.

Please be aware of owning, possessing, keeping, or harboring any animal, which by loud and frequent barking, howling, or yelping shall cause annoyance or disturbance to any of the citizens of the city.

Your cooperation in addressing these matters helps keep Harrah a beautiful and healthy place to live. Thank you for your attention to this important reminder. If you have any issues or questions, call the Code Enforcement Officer at 405-454-1203 and provide the address of the property in question.
