Blacksmith Park: A Tribute to Our Heritage

The town of Harrah was founded by Polish immigrants in the late 1800s and early 1900s. One of these settlers, Walter Brzozowski, established a vital blacksmith shop, which was essential for the community and its farmers. He provided services like shoeing horses and repairing farm equipment.

That historic location is now being transformed into Blacksmith Park. This new public space honors Harrah's history, the contributions of its early Polish settlers, and the importance of the blacksmith's trade. The City of Harrah hosted a dedication ceremony to celebrate the site's significance on the 21st of September. We invite you to Come watch the park grow!
