#### The Bald Eagle

The area along the North Canadian River Valley in Harrah is a winter nesting site for the Bald Eagle, the national bird of the United States! Keep an eye on the large trees near the river this winter. You might just spot our national symbol soaring overhead or perched high on a branch! The peak time for viewing migratory Bald Eagles in Oklahoma is typically January and February, though they begin arriving in late November and stay until early March. Eagles are fishing raptors, so look for them near open water—specifically along the North Canadian River. They often perch in the tallest trees, like Cottonwoods, that offer good visibility and unobstructed views of the water for hunting. Your best chances are early morning (around sunrise) or late afternoon (sunset), as they leave their communal roosts to hunt or return for the night.
