Wiegert wants staff to work on building some teeth into the multi use ordinance. He wants the Planning Commission to work on establishing some rules for the ordinance.

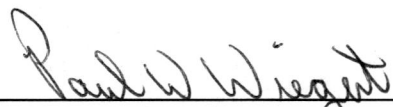
McCammond wants to start working on strategic planning again.
