Sellers mentioned some concerns he had with the agreement, would like the agreement amended to clarify the language in section 2 as to who they report to, wants the deliverables spelled out, wants it to state who controls the attorney search process and what happens if we get to October 9th and the search is incomplete.

A motion was made by Glenn and seconded by Sellers to approve the professional services agreement with The Childs Law Firm, PLLC to provide services in support of recruiting a City Attorney with the requested amendments.

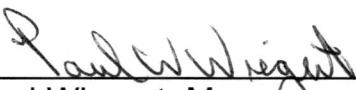
